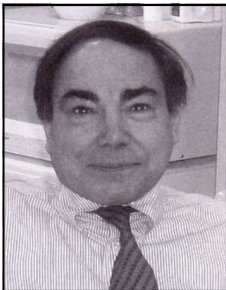

- 30% Earth Science

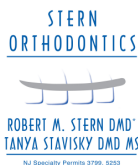

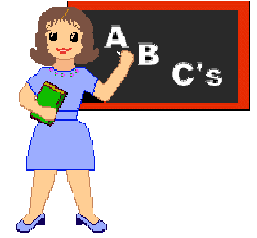

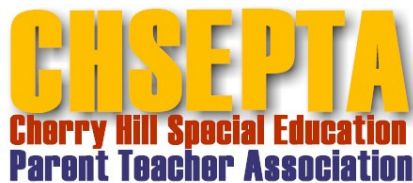

Budget Conversations with the Board of Education

In an effort to make the budget process transparent and inclusive, the Cherry Hill Board of Education wants to meet and discuss the proposed school budget and other issues with as many residents as possible.
