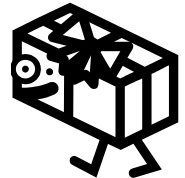

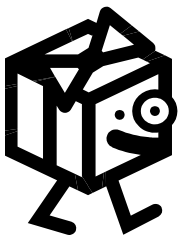


How It Works:
