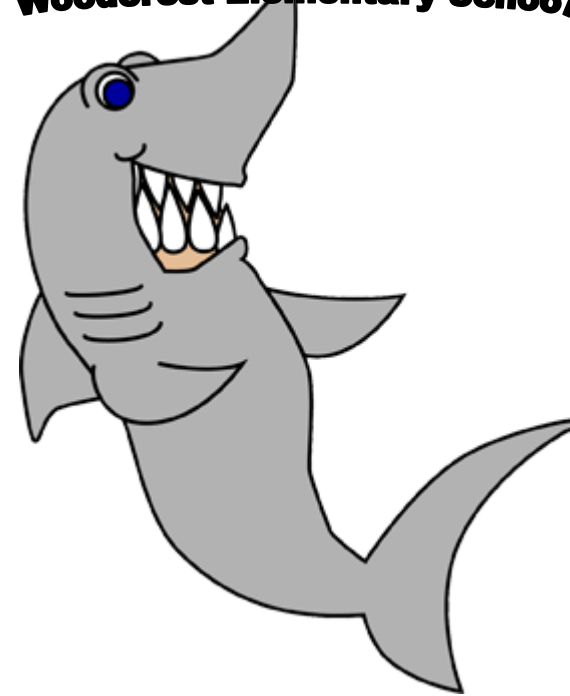

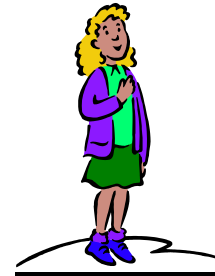


Character Pledge
